**U-Gas Convenience Stores/CCM Corporation**

**Background:**

CCM Corporation, representing the U-Gas convenience store chain, needed five “grab ‘n’ go” self-service cases with self-contained refrigeration that could be positioned in the middle of the store. Each case required a top exit electrical stub out, which required engineering as a special project. They also had to be delivered to different stores on the same day – all within eight weeks.

**Solution:**

Hussmann delivered five 10-foot multi-deck island cases (RI2N) with special electrical kits in less than eight weeks, thanks to outstanding performances by sales, engineering and manufacturing personnel at the Bridgeton, MO, location.



In addition to the tight delivery schedule, all five stores had no dock to unload the cases and required a lift gate truck for delivery. But because the cases were so big, no lift gate truck was available with the size needed. So a traveling forklift and forklift driver were sent along on the trailers to lift the cases. There was also a traveling door crew that had to remove the entrance doors at each location to get the cases inside.

Not only was the customer pleased with the delivery, he also said the cases were “exceptional in appearance and marketability.” In addition to working with U-Gas, CCM Corporation also represents the Dirt Cheap Liquor stores in the metro St. Louis area and other convenience stores.
