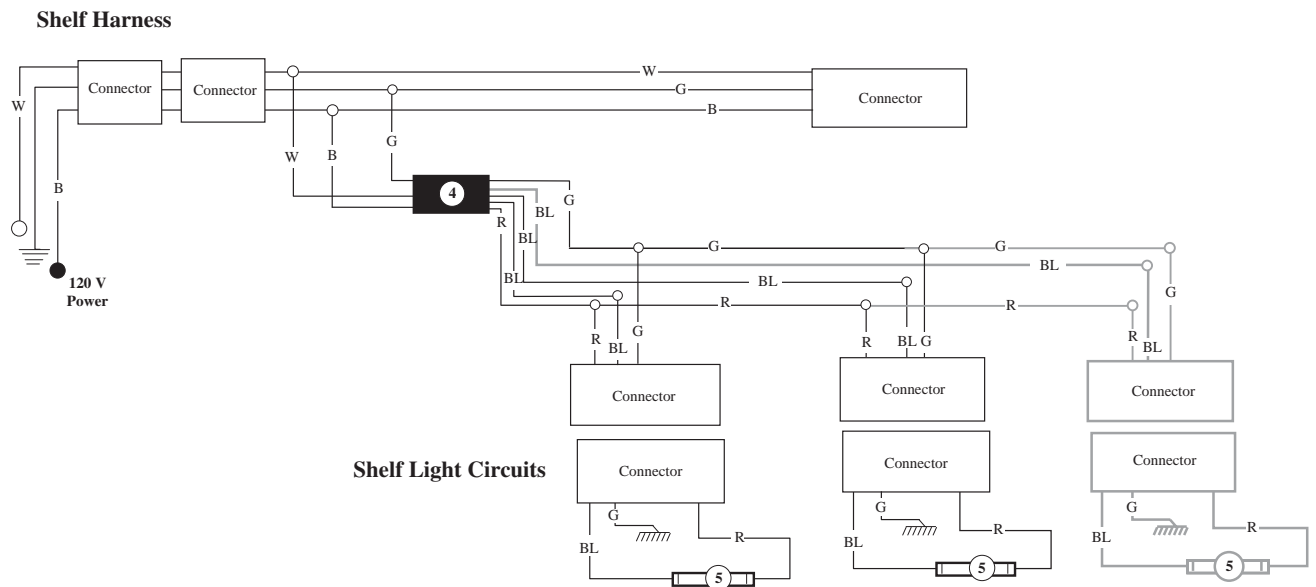
Fan Wiring Offtime Defrost

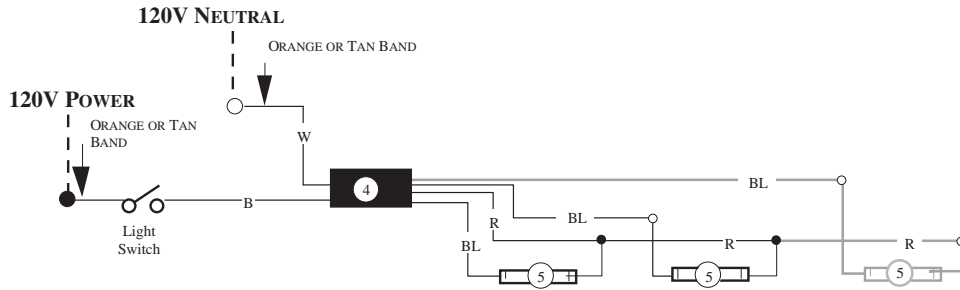

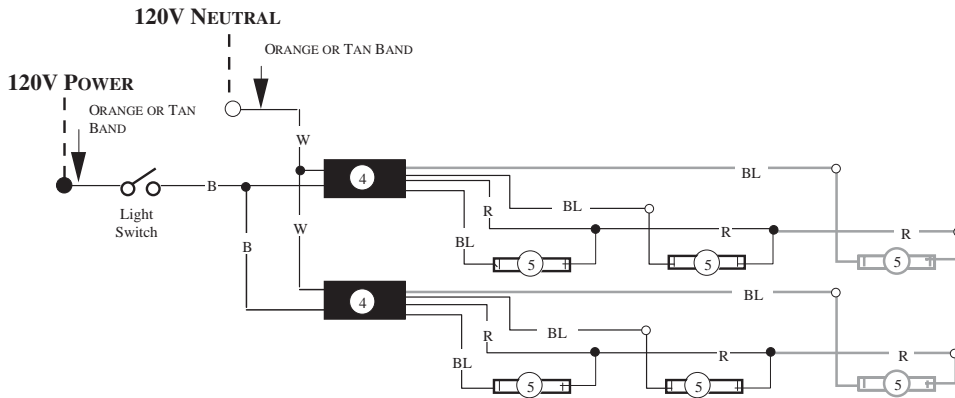

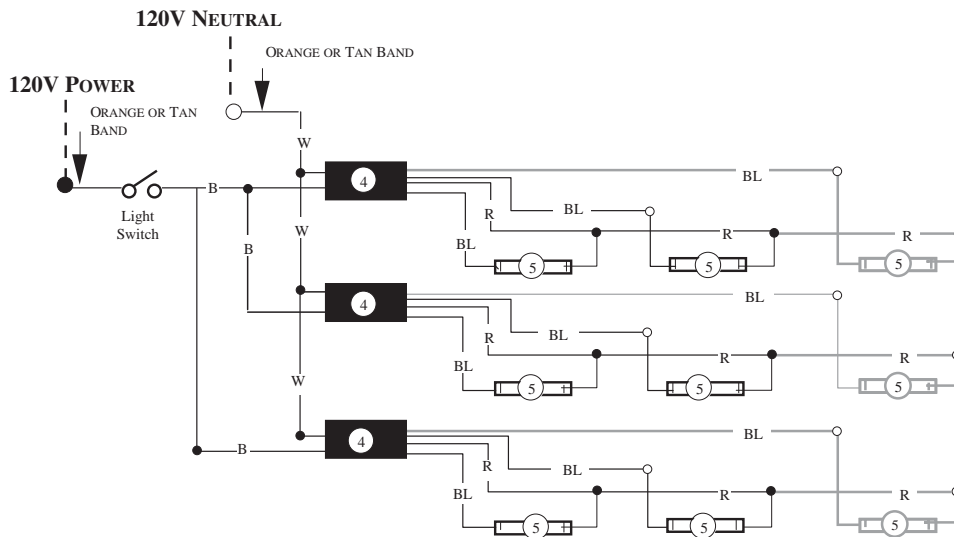
Standard Lighting 1 Row Canopy or Optional 1 Row Rail
